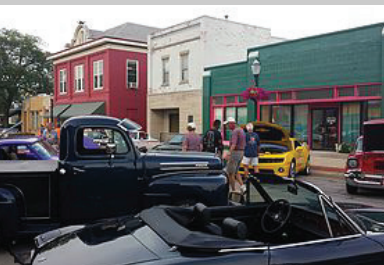

# Snap Shot of Genoa, Ohio

Genoa has two commercial districts: our historic downtown and the Route 51 corridor. Local businesses range from small diners and sole proprietors to multi-million independent manufacturers/service businesses plus dollar stores and popular franchises.

We are proud of our world-class park located in the downtown area. It features four ball fields (three others located in town), disk golf, pickleball, shuffleboard, four tennis courts, three soccer fields, sand volleyball pit, three shelter houses and a fresh-water quarry that's a half-mile around and 80 feet deep.
